WHAT DO I NEED BEFORE APPLYING?

Our students come from varied allied and behavioral health backgrounds. The following prerequisites are required for our applicants:

- ENGL& 101 English Composition (or equivalent) with a 2.0 grade or higher
- 15 credits of general education with a 1.0 grade or higher per course
- 25 credits of proficiency coursework with a 2.0 grade or higher per course

Proficiency coursework can come from a variety of fields, including: patient care, pharmacy, medical assisting, dental assisting, clinical lab assisting, nursing, physical therapy assisting, radiology, surgical technology, addiction studies, and mental health.
